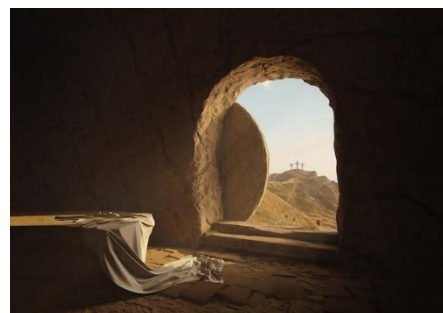

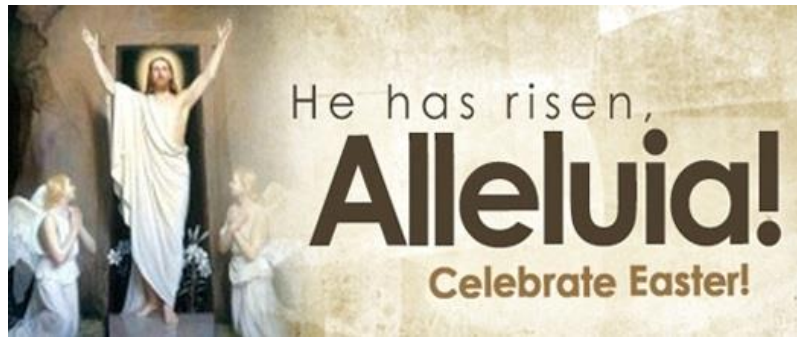
How do we witness the power of Jesus' resurrection in our daily lives? Has the unconditional gift of God's outstretched arms made a difference in our lives?
