


## **HAPPY EASTER SUNDAY! HE IS RISEN, ALLELUIA!**

celebration, we acknowledge that Jesus' resurrection gives us hope. His victory over sin and death offers us a new commitment.






How do we witness the power of Jesus' resurrection in our daily lives? Has the unconditional gift of God's outstretched arms made a difference in our lives?
