## **THE EPIPHANY OF THE LORD 4TH JANUARY 2026**

The Second Sunday after the Nativity of the Lord in the Catholic Church is a time for profound reflection on the Incarnation and its implications for our lives. The readings often highlight the ongoing mystery of God becoming human, emphasizing how this event bridges the divine and the human. We are reminded that Jesus' birth is not just a historical event but a continuous revelation of God's love and presence in the world.

This Sunday's liturgy typically focuses on the continuity between the Old and New Testaments, showing how Jesus fulfills ancient prophecies. We see Jesus as the Word of God made flesh, the ultimate revelation of God's plan for salvation.
